

What is going on at Cattail Creek?

A new 9-hole mini-course is under construction. The new mini course will be a hybrid of a putting course and a SNAG-friendly golf course. The natural grass playing surface will allow traditional golfers the opportunity to play a challenging putting course, while the SNAG-friendly design offers a fun and new option for playing golf.

The putting course will be exactly as it sounds, 9-holes of golf played with only a putter. The SNAG concept will be new to many people, and does not require any previous playing experience. SNAG is very similar to golf, but SNAG is played with only 2 clubs, the Launcher and the Roller. The ball is safe, constructed like a tennis ball, and only flies about 40 yards. The SNAG golf hole ends when the ball sticks to the "flagsticky". The putting course hole ends as normal with a golf ball in the cup. And yes, they CAN be played at the same time.

SNAG, by its design and nature, is fun and exciting and is a wonderful, non-intimidating way to enter the sport of golf. Who do you know that would love to learn to play?
