## Cattail Creek Mini Course FAQs





- 1. When is the course open? Current operating hours are 11:00a.m.—close. However, this will change in 3 or 4 weeks when the weather cools and early morning hours can be added.
- 2. The new course is just for kids right? Wrong! The multi-use design of the course makes it playable for almost every age. Ex. A veteran golfer can putt the course while a grandchild plays with the SNAG equipment at the same time! We have watched golfers of all ages and skill enjoy the course.
- 3. How far does the ball travel? About 50 yards on average.
- 4. How long are the holes? The holes range in length from 30—63 yards for SNAG golf and 26—50 yards for putting.
- 5. Can I use my own equipment? If you are putting yes. If you are going to play SNAG golf, the specialized equipment is required. The Cattail Creek pro shop has SNAG equipment for rent for \$2.00 per round.
- 6. Can I use my own equipment to pitch and putt? Due to safety reasons, only putting is allowed with a real golf ball.
- 7. Are there lessons? Leagues? Yes Fall adult and youth lessons are forming now along with putting and SNAG leagues. Inquire at the Cattail Creek pro shop for more information.
