SUMMER 2013, JUNIOR GOLF PROGRAM

The next steps to a lifetime of golf

Beginner Golfers 9 years and older (Level 1): This program is for the new-to-golf youth golfer or the young golfer who could benefit from concentrated skills instruction, review, and practice. Overall program includes 3 days of instruction using both SNAG equipment and skills along with regulation equipment, 2 days of learning hole to play golf holes on the Mini-Course, and 2 days of supervised play on the Cattail Creek Par 3 regulation course.

Start date: Tuesday June 4, 9:00 am. First week Tuesday June 4 through Friday June 7 is mandatory. Golfers then continue the program on an individual basis with play day opportunities every Thursday; tee times begin at 9:00 am. Final play day is Thursday, August 1. Program participates can sign up to take advantage of additional group lessons throughout the summer.

Cost: Registration Fee for program \$50.00; Plus \$7 golf round fee payable each time a play day is played. A 10 round multi-play punch pass can be purchased for \$56.00

Intermediate Golfers 9 years and older (Level 2): For golfers who have a demonstrated knowledge of the golf skills necessary for independent play. Held at the Cattail Creek golf course, golfers can scheduled tee times for play days on Mondays beginning at 9:00 am. Program participants can sign up for group lessons throughout the summer.

Start Date: Monday, June 3, 9:00 am

Cost: Registration Fee for program \$50.00; Plus \$7 golf round fee payable each time a play day is played.

Advanced Golfers 11 years and older (Level 3): For golfers who have a demonstrated knowledge of the golf skills necessary for independent play. Held at The Olde Course at Loveland, this program is for golfers who can handle playing a longer course. Golfers can scheduled 9-hole tee times for play days on Tuesday's beginning at 1:00 pm. Program participants can sign up for group lessons throughout the summer.

Cost: Registration Fee for program \$50.00; Plus \$9 golf round fee payable each time a play day is played.

The Masters at Mariana Butte: Boys and Girls 11-17 (Level 4): For Juniors looking to play CJGA, High School or tournament golf, this program is for you.
