This meeting was called to order by Chairperson Pat Kistler at 6:34. A motion was made by John Tindall and seconded by Dennis Soucek to approve the April 7, 2014 minutes as is. All approved. Motion Carried. A Mountain View High School student, Gabby Valland attended the meeting as part of a class assignment.

Captain Bob Klinger presented the Strategic Leadership Plan and discussed all four pillars; Organization Strategies, Community Outreach, Technology and Staffing. Highlights included the availability of 911 texting by September, 2014, e-citations by officers, and questions from the Board regarding staffing transfers in and out of the investigations bureau.

He discussed the cost of the various radios and cameras that are available to the department, current officer staffing due to injuries, and the private gun range being proposed for Johnstown. He also discussed the status of various consortiums of radio interagency radio communication opportunities for the department.

Bev Cardarelli asked him about the current status of safety vests, especially in relation to summer wear. Captain Klinger addressed that issue and the updates being proposed to the policy of wearing some protection when in uniform.

Carla Sprague will be retiring from the department after 31 years with the city. Her replacement should be on board in a couple of weeks.

Loveland Community Night Out will be Wednesday, June 18. Pat Kistler and John Tindall will be participating.

There was no report by City Councilor Hugh McKean since he was not in attendance.
