Introduction of The Olde Course at Loveland Clubhouse Staff and 2014 Goals	Gale Stiner reviewed the information included in the packet regarding staff. The LPGA girls' golf program continues; trying new program of "achieving" levels and receiving different buffs for the accomplishment. Have been brainstorming ways to address perceived barrier to beginning golf. Added two new lines to pro shop merchandise options and have added new menu items to the grille selections.. SUMMARY:

The Olde Course at Loveland will host the running of the Valley 5000 on 08/15/2014 at 7:00 p.m.

Race proceeds support the House of Neighborly Service (HNS) celebrating over 50 years of providing basic needs service including food baskets, prescription and utility assistance, emergency shelter, transportation, clothing and household items to eligible low-income families in the Thompson School District. HNS also sponsors programs to provide money for needy school-age children and matches families in need with other families for Christmas baskets and gifts.

From the Valley 5000 Web Site: Route Map The race/walk will begin at The Olde Course at Loveland Golf Course - If you don't play golf but always wanted to see this beautiful course, here's your chance! If you do play golf and have wondered what it would be like to run or walk the course instead, here is your opportunity! This course features ponds, green grass, large trees, outstanding scenery, and NO motor vehicle traffic to worry about. Runner/walkers are welcome to run on the cart path or the adjacent grassy areas.

The walk will begin on hole number 1 Tee Box (just northeast of the Club House. Then we will follow the cart path to holes 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 13, 14; cross the bridge over to 15, 17, 11; cross the bridge to 10, and then finish behind the club house (by the Putting Green).

The Olde Course will close for play at approximately 1:00 p.m. following a morning shotgun tournament.
