



# Spill Watch 2014

Lake Granby began spilling on Wednesday, July 16, when the water level reached 8279.50 feet. Lake Granby’s full elevation is 8280.00 feet. However, a spill begins when the water level reaches 8279.50 feet. Yesterday, Lake Granby’s water level increased 0.04 feet. Today, Lake Granby has 536,133 acre-feet of water storage.
