The purpose of this letter is to notify FERC of the City of Loveland's intent to surrender the license for Project No. P-2829. The City of Loveland is pursuing surrender because the project was severely damaged during the rain and resulting flooding beginning on September 13, 2013. The dam and portions of the penstock were completely removed, with permission from FERC, the United States Forest Service and the United States Army Corps of Engineers.

We will deliver a complete application for surrender within 90 days of the date of this letter.
