### **NON-ACTION/INFORMATION ITEMS**

<b>Big Thompson River Recovery</b>	Steve Southard reviewed information regarding the Big Thompson River corridor. River engineers have been hired by the City to address necessary “repairs.” The Golf Fund with split the engineering costs (est. at \$100,000) with the Open Lands Fund for the area including Mariana Butte and the adjoining Morey Pond. The engineering costs do not include actual “construction” costs to complete the repairs. Steve said that the main goal of any river correcting plans is to “do no harm to neighboring properties;” or, said another way - you cannot do anything in the flood plain that would push more water towards adjoining properties.
<b>Board/Staff Tournament</b>	Andrea Sheldon reviewed the information regarding the annual Board/Staff tournament. The July Golf Advisory Board meeting is cancelled.
<b>Valley 5000</b>	Steve reviewed the information in the agenda. The annual Valley 5000 5K Run/Walk will be held on The Olde Course at Loveland on 08/15/14 at 7:00 pm.

<b>Growing the Game</b>	Steve discussed results of a recent survey of the Loveland golf course customers. The question was asked “How did you learn
