Chair Robert Walkowicz called the regular meeting of the Loveland Golf Advisory Board to order Wednesday, September 23, 2015 at 5:15 pm.

NON-ACTION/INFORMATION ITEMS

The Olde Course at Loveland: Project Summary, Holes 5 & 9

Steve Southard reviewed the timeline and projects completed in association with the changes made to holes 5 and 9 at The Olde Course at Loveland. Project began in late 2011 with the lowering of the lake on #5; the dirt that came out of the lake was used across the street at Cattail Creek in the construction of the Mini-Course. A new tee was created on #9, the fairways on 5 & 9 were able to be separated, a new small cart path spur was added on 9 and the small, shallow trench/ditch between 5 and 9 was filled in and leveled. Ultimately, due to the improvements, the in-course, out of bounds between 5 and 9 was removed.

Mariana Butte Golf Course: Project Update: 16 Bridge

The bridge on 16 was damaged during the flood of 2013; replacement of the bridge will be accomplished with FEMA funds. The project has been put out for bid and will include Big Thompson River bank stabilization. The project should begin in mid-October.

Preparation for 2015 Policy and Procedures Manual Review for 2016

Andrea Sheldon distributed copies of the 2015 Policy and Procedure Manual. Board members should review the manual for suggested changes/revisions for 2016.

DISCUSSION/ACTION

Operational Changes at The Olde Course at Loveland: Food and Beverage Concessions

Robert Walkowicz opened the topic and stated that this discussion was the second in a series of 3 regarding operations at The Olde Course at Loveland; the pro shop operations; the scope of food and beverage; and the scope of programming/lessons.

Steve Southard presented the options available that include extending the scope of service to Cattail Creek.

Board Discussion centered on extending concession scope to Cattail Creek and whether that should include the sale of alcohol. Hope Chrisman moved that the City of Loveland include Cattail Creek in the scope of services for a new Food and Beverage Concessionaire and that the sale of alcohol at Cattail be approved; pending City Liquor License process. Jim Whitenight seconded with unanimous approval.

Steve Southard asked the Board to begin to think about the scope of instructional services offered for the next meeting.

POLICY CHANGES in regards to

General: Alcohol:

2015 Alcohol: Pursuant to the Loveland Municipal Code and all applicable statutes of the State Liquor Code, persons may have alcoholic beverages on the course and in the facilities only if purchased from course/facility concessions. Alcohol not purchased from course/facility concessions is prohibited. All alcohol is prohibited at Cattail Creek.

2016 Policy Change:

Pursuant to the Loveland Municipal Code and all applicable statutes of the State Liquor Code, persons may have alcoholic beverages on the course and in the facilities only if purchased from course/facility concessions. Alcohol not purchased from course/facility concessions is prohibited.

POLICY CHANGES in regards to

Golf Cart Use: Rental Carts:

2014: Rental Golf Carts

The City maintains golf carts at the courses available for rent. Only adults (ages 18 years and above) with valid driver's licenses who complete the Golf Cart Rules and Rental Agreement in its entirety are eligible to rent City-owned golf carts. (See Appendix D for form) Generally, no more than 2 people are allowed per golf cart. An exception to this rule is made for youth spectators who ride with an adult. Golf carts are charged at single (one individual) and full rates (two individuals). Youth spectators ride free and do not count toward golf cart occupancy.

2016 Policy Change: ... Youth spectators ride free and do not count toward golf cart occupancy. Adult spectators, not playing golf, will be charged ½ normal cart fee.

POLICY CHANGES in regards to

Twilight & 3-Hole Round Golf

2015: 3 Hole-Round: The 3-Hole Round rate offers a discount from the normal daily fee and is designed to allow 3 holes of play. The 3-Hole Round Rate is available anytime Monday – Friday and Saturday and Sundays after 1:00 pm

2016 Policy Change: The 3-Hole Round rate offers a discount from the normal 9-hole daily fee and is designed to allow 3 holes of play. The 3-Hole Round Rate is available anytime Monday – Sunday.
