- ➤ Valid EMT-B or greater from the State of Colorado.
 - -NREMT Certification from out of state will be considered
- > S130/190 Wildland Red Card
- ➤ Valid Firefighter 2 certification with IFSAC or Pro Board Seal
- NAPD (National Association of Professional Drivers) Certification

*CANDIDATE PHYSICAL ABILITY TEST (CPAT)

Successful completion of a physical agility test is an LFR requirement. Proof of completion of a CPAT within one year prior to application end from any validated testing site will be accepted. If needed you may contact

POST ACADEMY

LFR Volunteer Firefighters are required to contribute a minimum of:

- ➤ 36 hours of shift time per month in one of the five staffed stations
- ➤ 36 hours per year of sanctioned training by LFR

Please note: Paid Firefighter positions are open only to those actively volunteering with LFR
