Proclamation

WHEREAS, Miss Loveland Valentine, Loveland's spokesperson, spends early February visiting organizations and children around Loveland and is recognized each year by legislators and the Governor at the Colorado State Capitol; and

WHEREAS, on February 1st, custom love notes stenciled onto wooden red hearts are placed on lamp posts throughout the city, helping residents and visitors celebrate their love for each other in the Sweetheart City; and

WHEREAS, the People of Loveland, local organizations, and outside groups come together to celebrate Valentine's Day from February 1 through February 14 with custom craft beer, coffee, stamping valentines, special events, and other activities; and




