

DISABILITIES ADVISORY COMMISSION (DAC)

Roles and Duties

Background

This Commission was established May 18, 1982 as the Handicapped Advisory Commission (Ord. #2037), with 8 members. Four (4) additional members were added to this commission on January 20, 1987 (Ord. #3384). April 15, 2003 the Commission was renamed to the Disabilities Advisory Commission (Ord. #4779)

Roles and Duties of the Commission

The duties are established by Municipal Code 2.60.100, as follows:

Disabilities advisory commission.

A. There is established a disabilities advisory commission consisting of twelve members appointed by the city council. The term of office of each member shall be three years.

B. The purpose of the disabilities advisory commission shall be to study problems relating to disabled persons and their interaction with the community and to serve as an advisory body to the city council on such matters.
