TEEN VOLUNTEER SERVICE PROJECT

The Loveland Public Library Teen volunteers partnered with the Loveland Chamber of Commerce's Leadership Loveland group for #RandomActsofLOVEland. #RandomActsofLOVEland is a leadership project that is designed to promote kindness and raise funds for the Thompson Education Foundation. The teens created balloons with notes of kindness attached to them and hung them around the Civic Center on March 26th. 35 teens attended the program for a whopping 105 hours of teen volunteer service in one day!

AWE COMPUTING

Childrens has special computers for kids in their area. They are called AWE computers and come with special software that is designed to promote early literacy. These computers are designed with children in mind and invite them to sit down at them. Last year, Childrens updated all their AWE computers. These continue to be a popular feature in the Childrens' area with over 3000 users in 2018.

TECHNICAL SERVICES BEHIND THE SCENES

Technical services is the "Behind the Scenes Machine". Their touch is everywhere. For March, 1,612 records were placed in PIKA and 1,236 items were released to the shelf. They are all about putting the patrons first. Technical Services prioritizes the cataloging of new items as well as improving the ease of location for both patrons and staff.

This is how we did just that for the month of March:

1. All backlog items have been caught up.
2. All rush items have a less than 48-hour turnaround time (from receiving to cataloging/labeling).
3. Relabeling project of Children's Non-Fiction DVDs is 50% completed.
4. Relocation of YA to AS CD's have been completed! All CD's will now be found in adult services.
5. Teen paperback project is now on the author's last name beginning with "K". We will meet our deadline of completion by Summer Reading.
6. JPB relocation project is now on author's last name beginning with "T".
7. In March, Technical Services kept their cataloging error rate below 2% (the department's goal is an error rate of 3% and below).





CIRCULATIONS




MAR CIRCULATION
