Colorado – Adventures in the Rockies

Colorado is a year-round destination where visitors come to discover 11 National Parks and Monuments and 58 mountain peaks that top 14,000 feet, known as 'Fourteeners'. It's a place to become immersed in the history of the Wild West and meander along endless kilometres of scenic drives. Affluent skiers have always enjoyed the challenging slopes of Colorado but there's more to this bountiful state when the snow melts. It's a destination for adventure and to feel alive and it's where I spent a few days in May this year - here are a few of my highlights.

Channel your inner cowboy

Colorado is steeped in the legacy of the Wild West with a dude ranch the place to saddle up and channel your inner cowboy. I got to experience two. Devil's Thumb Ranch Resort Spa which opened in 1938 is an upscale, friendly year-round ranch, offering real, authentic ranch activities from Nordic skiing to horseback riding, cattle driving and fly fishing all on 6,000 wilderness acres. However, it was the simple pleasure of a wagon ride to feed the horses and curling up with a good book by the heated outdoor swimming pool, a pool with a million-dollar view that got the biggest thumbs up from me. The ranch is located just outside Winter Park and about a 90-minute drive from Denver. If you are looking for an authentic western experience but without the high altitude and with close proximity to urban activities, then I can suggest Sylvan Dale Guest Ranch in Loveland (the closest guest ranch to Denver International Airport). Family members of all ages can bond through wholesome old-fashioned fun, this is the perfect ranch for a multi-generational holiday, dude lite so to speak. The trail ride to the top of Eagle Ridge for BBQ steak, followed by a campfire and s'mores (for those not in the know fire-roasted marshmallows and a layer of chocolate sandwiched between two pieces of cracker, yummy but messy) was also a winner as was meeting the highly entertaining sprightly owner Susan Jessup. Sylvan Dale Ranch has been owned by the Jessup family since 1946.



Explore Rocky Mountain National Park and the Trail Ridge Road

With high-mountain lakes, water-falls and streams, sky scraping peaks more than 4,200 metres above sea level, thick evergreen forests and wildlife (including elk, bighorn sheep, mule deer, moose and more) the Rocky Mountain National Park conjures up what most people imagine when they think of the Rockies and for me it didn't disappoint. Spring was the most glorious colour filled season to visit, the lush green landscape bursting with wildflower pinks, reds and yellows whilst the mountains were still topped with snow. Between May and mid-October, the Trail Ridge Road (the highest continuous paved road in the USA) takes drivers over mountain ridges, past weathered tundra overlooking sweeping valleys and into the clouds. It's the sort of road you want to stop every 5 minutes to take another photo of yet another glorious vista, you're practically guaranteed a post-card worthy shot every time, and when even they become passé, other surprises await including a super cute marmot or 'whistle pig' named for the sound it makes when it communicates or perceives a threat, posing in the sunshine.

Take an exhilarating motorcycle side car tour

Riding in a classic Russian Ural cT sidecar motorcycle offers an altogether different way of exploring the region. Travelling in a motorcycle side car might conjure up images of George and Mildred or Wallace and Grommit but with the wind in my hair and a 360-degree view of the surrounding peaks, this was seriously cool. City on the Side operate tours with commentary coming through a bluetooth headset with your driver.

Experience wildlife in Estes Park and try out rock climbing

Known as the base camp for Rocky Mountain National Park, the mountain village of Estes Park is home to wildlife including elk and bears. The stately Elk are the unofficial mascots of Estes Park. They can be seen walking across the road, grazing in the meadows or even snoozing on the golf course. If you fancy dangling from a rope, Estes Park Mountain Shop is the place to have a go at rock climbing (there is no age limit). Strong legs from all the cycling I do in London made me pretty successful on the outdoor bouldering wall but I'm not sure if I'm brave enough to venture higher.



Unwind in Loveland

The town of Loveland is just a short 22 km drive south of Fort Collins. Colorado's sweet heart city has become famous for its Valentine's Day love stamp programme, but its bronze foundries, numerous galleries, local art programme, parks and brewery tours are equally impressive. View an extraordinary permanent collection of 164 works of art in one of the most unique sculpture gardens in the world. Recognised as 'one of the 200 most important modern and contemporary art sites around the world', Benson Sculpture Garden has been providing a unique outdoor setting for showcasing sculpture since 1985. Wheelchair friendly and easy to navigate, this is the place to embrace your artistic side and makes for a peaceful place to unwind.



A couple of things to be aware of, Colorado's high altitude means the air is thinner and the sun stronger whilst the average humidity (measured at noon) is 38 percent, 50 percent less than at sea level. The lack of humidity means it's easier to become dehydrated, so drinking water, lots of it, is essential. The tap water also tastes better than bottled water so be eco-friendly and re-fill your water bottle. Historically a second-time state for many UK travellers, Colorado is currently experiencing a buzz with new non-stop flights. Mine was a whistle stop visit but with the new easier access and the natural beauty stirring a thirst to get out and enjoy every moment, I've made myself a promise to return.

Brand execs outline brand growth prospects in South America

Executives with Marriott International, Hyatt Hotels Corporation, InterContinental Hotels Group and Hilton speaking at the South American Hotel Investment Conference in Medellin, Colombia, shared their optimism and what opportunities there are for development in South America, writes Hotel News Now's Stephanie Ricca.

Camilo Bolanos, VP of development and real estate at Hyatt Hotels Corporation, said the company has experienced "exponential growth in the last decade with Hyatt in Latin America."

"Just a decade ago, we had a base of less than 10 hotels in Latin America and the Caribbean, and we're up to 40 currently with a pipeline that will grow by a third over the next few years," he said.

How some Carolina hotels weathered Hurricane Florence

Hoteliers with properties in North and South Carolina said planning ahead for a crisis, along with the dedication of on-property staff, has helped to [mitigate the impact from severe weather caused by Hurricane Florence](#), HNN's editorial staff writes.

Tara Investments' VP Adam Zembruski said the area GM Brian Rafferty and his on-property staff were the reason the side-by-side Homewood Suites by Hilton Charleston Historic District and Holiday Inn Charleston Historic District were able to remain open and operate during the storm.

"The people that we have there are there for this reason: It's in their hearts," he said. "They like serving people during a crisis. ... They really stepped up, and we couldn't be more proud."

Metrics that point to a rebound for NYC hotels

Continued demand growth in New York City has been a foundation of [the market's performance recovery](#), writes HNN contributor Stephen Schindel, and the first half of 2018 is showing positive signs of a turnaround.

June 2018 produced one of the highest occupancy rates (91%) New York City has recorded, according to data from [STR](#), though the same trend can't be said for average daily rate. (STR is the parent company of HNN). Overall the market saw ADR decline in 2015, 2016 and 2017, but in the first two quarters of 2018, ADR was picking up.

Hotel brands, AHLA partner on employee safety initiative

The leaders of major international hotel brand companies along with the American Hotel & Lodging Association shared details about [a new employee safety initiative for the hotel industry](#), writes HNN's Bryan Wroten. The initiative, called the "Five-Star Promise," is aimed at providing enhanced sexual harassment training and employee safety devices, which brands intend to make a standard over the next few years.

"The companies here, along with many others, are committing to provide an additional layer of security to U.S. hotel employees by deploying safety devices," said outgoing AHLA President and CEO Katherine Lugar. "This can be an important line in additional protection, particularly for those whose job requires them to go room to room."

Deals and developments

- Project partners McWhinney and Stonebridge Companies are near completion on the 101-room Courtyard by Marriott in Loveland, Colorado, at Centerra, a mixed-use development. The hotel is expected to open in late 2018, and the partners are already planning to add to more hotels—a Homewood Suites and Hilton Garden Inn—at Centerra.
- Choice Hotels International announced it has opened its newest 86-room, dual-branded Sleep Inn and MainStay Suites property in Sarasota, Florida.
- Wingate by Wyndham announced the opening of 14 hotels, including its first hotel for the brand in China (the Wingate by Wyndham Sanya Luhuitou).
- Woodmont Lodging and Milestone Companies announced the acquisition of the 95-room SpringHill Suites by Marriott Winston-Salem Hanes Mall and the 91-room Home2 Suites by Hilton Winston-Salem Hanes Mall for an undisclosed price.
- AccorHotels has plans to expand its presence in the Americas with the SO/ Havana Paseo del Prado, part of the company's SO/ Hotels & Resorts, set to open in early 2020 in Havana, Cuba.
- Flamingo Beach Resort & Spa announced it is close to finalizing preparations for is multimillion-dollar rebranding to the Margaritaville Beach Resort Playa Flamingo. A soft opening is set for 1 November.

LOVELAND, Colo.—McWHINNEY, Colorado-based real estate investor and developer, and Stonebridge Companies, a privately owned hotel owner, operator, and developer headquartered in Denver, have partnered to deliver the fourth hotel in Loveland's Centerra master-planned community. Construction is underway on the Courtyard by Marriott property, which is planned to open in late 2018.

The Courtyard property is located in southeastern Centerra at the I-25 and U.S. 34 intersection off Sky Pond Drive and Centerra Parkway, just south of The Promenade Shops at Centerra. The four-story, 67,000-square-foot hotel has 101 guestrooms, a bistro, a lounge, 1,200 square feet of meeting space, a fitness center, a market, a pool and hot tub, and guest laundry. The hotel is the third Marriott property in Centerra. 2WR + Partners serves as the architect and Coe Construction as the general contractor for the project.

With occupancy and demand showing strong growth, the partnership is also planning to deliver two additional hotels in Centerra under the Homewood Suites and Hilton Garden Inn brands. According to the *Rocky Mountain Lodging Report*, the revenue per available room calculation for Loveland has increased 4.6 percent in the July 2018 year-to-date period compared to the same period in 2017. With the Loveland market's continued expansion, demand drivers for hospitality include nearby UHealth-Medical Center of the Rockies; corporate demands from major Northern Colorado employers such as Agrium, Inc.; transient leisure traffic from Rocky Mountain National Park; events at Larimer County Fairgrounds; and oil and gas exploration and production.

The Homewood Suites and Hilton Garden Inn hotels will offer approximately 100 keys each. Planned as a dual-brand property, one wing will operate as the Homewood Suites hotel and another as the Hilton Garden Inn. The hotels will share the lobby and community spaces. The 135,000-square-foot, five-story property will have a restaurant and bar, pool, fitness center, and meeting space. The hotels will sit immediately south of the Courtyard and will mark a total of three Hilton hotels in Centerra.

"Jointly, the three hotels will add more than 300 guestrooms to the area, catering to focused-service business travel and extended-stay needs," said David Crowder, general manager of Centerra and vice president of community development for McWHINNEY. "We feel that Centerra is the ideal setting to support Northern Colorado's continually growing demand for hospitality services. The properties are centrally located in the heart of the region and easily accessible to the multitude of community amenities here at Centerra, including shopping, dining, and entertainment at Promenade Shops at Centerra and the Centerra Marketplace as well as Chapungu Sculpture Park."

McWHINNEY is the owner, asset manager, and co-developer of the properties, with Stonebridge Companies as the co-developer and hotel manager. The partnership has previously delivered three hotels in Centerra, with the Residence Inn by Marriott, completed in 2005, as the most recent property. The partnership currently has six hotels in operation, including three in Anaheim, Calif.

"Stonebridge Companies is proud to expand its partnership with McWHINNEY," said Navin C. Dimond, founder, president, and CEO of Stonebridge Companies. "As a valued partner in our continued growth, our relationship with McWHINNEY has been very rewarding to date. 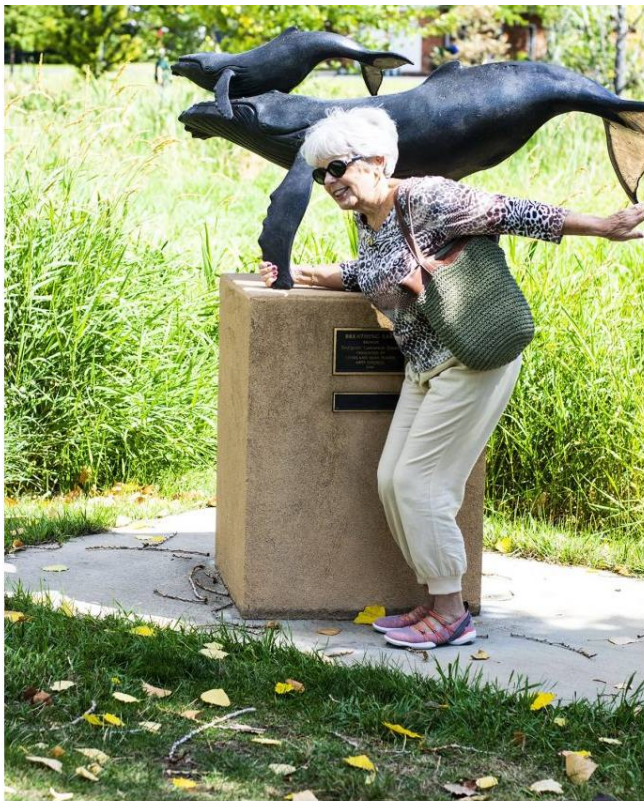

Billy Currington Unveils 'Bring It On Over'

Billy Currington has dropped a new song "Bring It On Over," reportedly his first track from an unnamed upcoming album.

It will be his first release since the 2017 single "Wake Me Up."

The lyrics of "Bring It On Over" were scripted by **Dallas Davidson**, **Rhett Akins**, **Ben Hayslip** and **Jesse Frasure**. Frasure and **Dann Huff** co-produced it.

"Oh baby, just wait a minute / If you're in the bed stay in it / I'm about to dive on in it," he sings on the new track.

He is set to perform at Thunder Mountain Amphitheatre in Loveland, Colorado, on Friday, and at Floore's in Helotes, Texas, next month.

Three singles from Currington's 2015 album *Summer Forever* were No. 1 hits: "Don't It," "It Don't Hurt Like It Used To" and "Do I Make You Wanna."

Billy Currington Returns With Sensual New Song 'Bring It on Over'

Billy Currington returns today with the new song "Bring It on Over," the singer's first release since the 2017 single "Wake Me Up."

Written by Dallas Davidson, Rhett Akins, Ben Hayslip and Jesse Frasure and produced by Frasure with Dann Huff, "Bring It on Over" is sleek, modern radio country that echoes recent, dance music-influenced work by Keith Urban and Thomas Rhett. Driven by a metronomic programmed beat and its 16th-note pulse, "Bring It on Over" conveys a sense of urgency about intimacy — Currington sings of being preoccupied with his lover, counting the minutes until he can return to her place. Oh baby, just wait a minute / If you're in the bed stay in it / I'm about to dive on in it," he sings, playing up his loverman persona with characteristic laid-back soul.

"Bring It on Over" also marks Currington's first release from an upcoming album project, though no further details are available at this time. Currington's previous album *Summer Forever* was released in 2015 and produced the Number One singles "Don't It," "It Don't Hurt Like It Used To," and "Do I Make You Wanna." That gives Currington 11 career Number Ones, stretching back to 2005's sultry smash "Must Be Doin' Somethin' Right" and the 2006 hit "Good Directions" (co-written by a pre-fame Luke Bryan with Rachel Thibodeau). In 2010, he scored a Grammy nomination for "People Are Crazy," the second single from 2008's *Little Bit of Everything*.

Currington has a handful of tour dates on the horizon, including a September 21st show at Thunder Mountain Amphitheatre in Loveland, Colorado and another on October 26th at

Loveland's Viestenz-Smith Mountain Park reopens five years after it was destroyed in the floods

Since 1926, many memories have been created at Viestenz-Smith Mountain Park — weddings, reunions, picnics and much more.

The Loveland city park in the Big Thompson Canyon is ready for the next round of memories, reopening Friday for the first time in five years since it was destroyed by the 2013 flood.

The park has changed from a manicured city park of green lawns and playgrounds to a [natural mountain park](#) with native grasses and trees, boulders and picnic shelters. And the Big Thompson River flows through a different spot, where it moved to naturally after the 1976 and 2013 floods.

Many partners spent the past few years designing and rebuilding the park for resilience, creating a natural haven in the canyon that could

park for resilience, creating a natural haven in the canyon that could withstand another flood. There are two, wider bridges, a paved area to access the river, a winding path, trees and a unique character.

That experience is now open for residents, and sunny, warm temperatures are forecast for its first weekend open since the flood that caused \$4 billion in damage across 24 counties and killed 10 people in Colorado, two who lived in nearby Cedar Cove, just down the canyon from the mountain park.

You already know how much Coloradans love their beer, so it would only make sense that they would also love Oktoberfest, which is basically the quintessential beer-drinking holiday (with some other fun stuff thrown in for good measure).

The Oktoberfest tradition dates back to 1810, when residents of Munich were invited to attend the wedding festivities of King Ludwig I and Princess Therese of Saxony-Hildburghausen. Over time, the annual celebration changed and grew, adding carousels, beer stands, tents and, finally, beer halls. Today, millions of people attend this two-week event in Germany, drinking plenty of beer and wine, and chowing down on traditional foods.

Can't make it to Munich this year? We've got you covered. Here's the ultimate guide to Oktoberfest celebrations around Colorado.

Sept. 8-Oct. 21.

Royal Gorge Route Railroad. This is cool: You can celebrate Oktoberfest on wheels with the Royal Gorge Route Railroad. As you roll through the colorful Royal Gorge, you'll be drinking beer and dining on food like duck roulade with stuffed quail spaetzle and vegetables or slow roasted pork shank. There's also an accordionist to serenade you while you take in the stunning scenery. *Santa Fe Depot, one block south of Highway 50 and 3rd Street, Cañon City, 719-276-4000, royalgorgeroute.com/special-events/oktoberfest.*

Sept. 14

Denver Union Station. On the patio of Union Station's Terminal Bar, you can drink your favorite Denver Beer Co. brews while jiving to live music by the Polkanauts, a band that plays a crazy mix of heavy metal hits and polka classics. If you're feeling bold, you can test your strength in the stein-holding competition. If you win, you get a longboard and a bunch of beer. Plus, there is always good people-watching at Union Station. *Denver Union Station Terminal Bar, 1701 Wynkoop St., Denver, 720-460-3701, terminalbardenver.com.*

Sept. 14-15

Steamboat Springs. OK, technically, the folks up in Steamboat Springs call it "OktoberWest," but you get the picture. The festivities kick off Friday night with a beer stroll through downtown Steamboat. You'll get a mug when you arrive at The Chief Theater so that you can wander around the town and taste beers at 20 different restaurants. You'll have all morning Saturday to rest up before heading to Steamboat Mountain Village for the afternoon "I Love Beel" cookoff and tasting event, the OktoberWest festival and ... more beer (at the beer garden of course). *Downtown Steamboat Springs and Steamboat Mountain Village, 970-846-7050, steamboatoktoberwest.com.*

Loveland. Loveland's Oktoberfest is moving to a new home this year since it's experiencing rapid growth. The German-style beers will be flowing, including Grimm Brothers Brewhouse's Farmer's Daughter Oktoberfest Lager. There's also a best-dressed contest, so break out your lederhosen and your dirndl, as well as a stein-hoisting contest and a "Barbarian dinner" where the only utensil allowed is a knife that you bring. Members of the Colorado State University Germany Club will be in attendance, too, talking about the history and culture of Oktoberfest. Plus, live music from at least three bands and a German drinking game tournament. *1015 S. Lincoln Ave., Loveland, lovelandoktoberfest.org.*

Pueblo. This is Pueblo's 28th year of celebrating Oktoberfest in style with live music, traditional folk-dancing performances, a German costume contest, mouthwatering German food and, of course, tons of German beer. You can also do a special beer tasting, with more than 50 imported beers to choose from for your samples. The fun kicks off with a keg tapping at 6 p.m. Friday and continues into Saturday. *Pueblo Union Depot, 132 W. B. St., Pueblo, 719-544-0020, pueblouniondepot.com.*

Sept. 14-16

Parker. The folks in Parker don't mess around — they're hosting three days of Oktoberfest events, including performances by several traditional German bands playing polkas, waltzes and marches. There's also a Dachshund race (cue the "awwwws") and a pageant to determine the annual Oktoberfest princess, queen, Ms. and Mrs. If you like to dance, you'll want to check out the late-night German electronic dance parties, with beats by DJ Eric Von Beerstein (who has the best stage name in the history of DJs ever). Parker is also hosting special performances by Grimm Fairytale actors and actresses, who will also be around all weekend if your kids want to say hi. *O'Brien Memorial Park, 10795 Victorian Drive, Parker, coloradoculture.org/oktoberfest.*

Littleton. Schatz's Oktoberfest in Littleton has been going strong since 2002, and this year is no different. There's tons of live music, a parade through downtown Littleton, a ceremonial tapping of the beer keg and performances of "Cinderella" by Storybooks and Sparkles Children's Theatre. The Denver Kickers Schuhplattler group will also be performing traditional Bavarian folk and plattler dances throughout the day on Saturday. Plus, Littleton's Oktoberfest festivities include tons of quirky competitions, such as the royal stick horse races, a yodeling competition, Dachshund races and costume contests, a moustache competition and stein hosting events. *Bega Park, 2250 W. Vail. This is the second weekend of Vail's annual Oktoberfest celebration, which includes lip-smacking Bavarian food such as bratwurst, wienerschnitzel sandwiches, pretzels, spaetzle and other tasty treats. They'll also be pouring steins of beer made by Spaten, which is one of just six official breweries you'll find at the real Oktoberfest party in Munich each year — in other words, the folks at Vail are making their Oktoberfest super authentic and bringing a little Munich to Colorado. There will also be concerts, stein-lifting competitions, keg-bowling contests (in which participants try to knock down a pyramid of empty kegs), bratwurst-eating contests and

Sept. 15

Fort Collins. In Northern Colorado, they don't just celebrate your run-of-the-mill Oktoberfest, they celebrate "Fortoberfest." From 1 to 10 p.m. in Fort Collins' Old Town Square, you can listen to some awesome live music from artists such as The Patti Fiasco, Taylor Scott Band and Cary Morin. Of course, there will be craft beer and wine, as well as German fare to munch on while you sing and dance. *Old Town Square, Fort Collins, 970-484-6500, downtownfortcollins.com/event/fortoberfest.*

DRiNK RiNo. As the organizers of this Oktoberfest event explain, it's not a beer tasting event, it's a beer *drinking* event. Hey, at least they're honest. When you attend the DRiNK RiNo Oktoberfest celebration, you'll find German food, games, live music and beer, wine, cider and craft spirits. *The Rackhouse, 2875 Blake St., Denver, rinoartdistrict.org/do/drink-rino-oktoberfest-2018.*

Sept. 15-16

Woodland Park. The Oktoberfest in Woodland Park has all the trappings of a traditional German party: There's a ceremonial keg tapping, live music, beer (duh), wienerschnitzel, brats with sauerkraut, jägerschnitzel, sauerbraten and pretzels. It's a family-friendly event, too, so bring the kids for the climbing wall, obstacle course, bounce house, face-painting and other activities (but you'll need to leave your pets at home). Parking is limited, but you can hop on a shuttle bus at Woodland Park High School. *Ute Pass Cultural Center, 210 E. Midland Ave., Woodland Park, 719-687-9885, oktoberfestplus.com.*

Sept. 21-22

Boulder. You can always count on Boulder to throw a good party, and Oktoberfest is no exception. Located at Central Park, Boulder's Oktoberfest festivities include live music, a stein-hoisting competition, a cornhole tournament, keg bowling, face painting, a photo booth and balloon art. There's also something called "gelande quaffing," a drinking game in which participants must slide a mug of beer across the bar to another team member, who must catch it and drink it. *Central Park, 1236 Canyon Blvd., Boulder, 1-855-732-3771, oktoberfestboulder.com.*

Sept. 21-23

Brush. If you like a little engine-revving with your German traditions, then you'll definitely want to head to Brush, where folks are celebrating their 36th annual Oktoberfest and car/motorcycle show. There's a little something for everyone at this three-day event: You can watch the cars and motorcycles cruise in for the weekend; bust a move at a street dance; run or walk a 5K race; watch a tractor-pull competition; or drink in the beer garden and listen to live polka and other performances. There are also games and crafts for kids, plus a costume contest for dogs. *Various locations, Brush, 970-842-2666, brushchamber.org/events/oktoberfest.html.*

Sept. 21-23 and 28-30

Denver. The Denver Oktoberfest celebration has been going since 1969, so you know it's the real deal. It started small with beer, pretzels and white radishes in front of Cafe Promenade in Larimer Square and has since ballooned into a gigantic party — more than 350,000 people attend each year. It has all the trappings of a traditional Oktoberfest celebration: stein-hoisting, live music, bratwurst eating competitions and delicious German fare. But there are also some unique elements, like the silent discos held each night of the event. *Larimer Street between 22nd and 20th streets, 720-771-7776, Denver, thedenveroktoberfest.com.*

Sept. 22

Highlands Ranch. This one-day party kicks off bright and early with a 5K running and walking race (lederhosen and running shoes, anyone?). Kids will enjoy the magician, balloon artists, rides, games and inflatables, while adults can look forward to the Paulaner beers and live music. There's also a dachshund race, which includes a prize for best-dressed pup. *Town Center South, Highlands Ranch, 303-791-2500, hrcaonline.org/about-us/guides-communication/calendar-schedules/event-detail/oktoberfest-celebration-and-5k-69.*

Sept. 28-30

Colorado Springs. In addition to live entertainment, you'll find tons of family-friendly activities at the Colorado Springs Oktoberfest this year. There's an 8K running race, a dachshund dash (costumes are encouraged), a stein-hoisting contest and lots of cornhole. If you feel like branching out from German beer, the festival is also hosting a wine tour, which is a tasting of six German wines, complete with information on the vineyards they came from and their history.

Sept. 29

Denver. The folks organizing Oktoberfest on South Pearl Street like to keep things pretty laid back. You'll find German food, games, a stein-holding competition and beers from brewers like Platt Park Brewing Company and Craft Alley, plus live music. What more could you ask for? *1500 block of South Pearl Street, Denver, southpearlstreet.com/oktoberfest.*

Montrose. Located in downtown Montrose, the Oktoberfest celebration includes beer from more than 30 craft breweries (most of them local to Colorado), plus tons of food trucks. You'll also get to participate in a group chicken dance (where do we sign up?) and watch live polka dancers, as well as musical performances by Dragondeer and Zolopht. There's also beer yoga, during which you drink beer while you get your zen on. If you want to start partying early, there's also a beer and small plates pairing event the night before with craft beer, cocktails and artisan foods. Plus, you can feel good about spending your weekend at Montrose Oktoberfest because

Sept. 29-30

Louisville. The folks who organize Louisville's Oktoberfest take it very seriously, so they've tried their hardest to incorporate super authentic Bavarian details into the festivities. That means hot potato soup, kase spaetzle, schnitzel, waffles with Nutella, pretzels with mustard, cakes and breads and tons of candies imported from Germany. There's also a 5K or 10K fun run for adults, and a one-mile race for kids. Oct. 5-6

Longmont. Longmont's Oktoberfest has a unique twist: The proceeds benefit the Left Hand Brewing Foundation and the St. Vrain Football Club Scholarship Program, so you can feel good about all the beer you drink there. (The event has raised more than \$246,000 since it was founded seven years ago.) Food trucks and more than 10 breweries will be on site serving up tasty beers and snacks. Plus, you can rock out to JJ Grey and his band Mofro, which has have a bluesy, Southern rock sound. The schedule also includes sack races for kids and adults, a costume contest and the ceremonial cooking of Colorado's longest bratwurst. *Roosevelt Park, 700 Longs Peak Ave., Longmont, lhbfoundation.org/longmont-oktoberfest.*

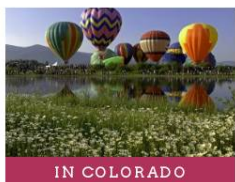

Here's the Rundown on Colorado's Thirty GABF medals

f Denver Beer Co. and New Belgium Brewing were the big winners among Colorado's breweries at the Great American Beer Festival, which ended Saturday. Both brought home two medals apiece. All together, the state added thirty medals to its GABF collection, half of them golds.

u **Denver Beer Co.** scored a gold for Graham Cracker Porter, which was one of the first beers it ever made and the one that put the brewery on the map back in 2011, when Graham Cracker Porter earned its first medal, a bronze. The brewery also scored gold for Barrel-Aged Japance Off, a version of DBC's sake yeast saison that was aged in red-wine barrels for eight months. This is the fourth year in a row that DBC has won a medal.

Fort Collins-based **New Belgium** took gold for Transatlantique Kriek in the brand-new Collaboration category, which GABF organizers created this year in order to celebrate the camaraderie that craft brewers are known for. Like the Pro-Am category, the Collaboration beers were judged not by style, but on their own merits. New Belgium teamed up with Belgium's 130-year-old Oud Beersel on this sour classic.

Dayblazer Easygoing Ale, New Belgium's foray into the lower-alcohol light lager marketplace, won silver in the American-Style Cream Ale category.

Fiction Beer Company also scored, winning one of the first-ever medals in the three new – and very popular – Juicy or Hazy categories. Madame Psychosis won a bronze for Juicy or Hazy Pale Ale and was the only Colorado brewery to medal for this style. Named for a character in David Foster Wallace's *Infinite Jest*, the beer is brewed with more than five pounds per barrel of Idaho 7, Mandarina Bavaria, Mosaic and Citra hops.

In a sweet symbol of validation, Wit's End Brewing won gold for Jean-Claude Van Blond, a Belgian-style blonde ale that won the same medal four years ago. Wit's End closed its taproom doors late last year but kept its beers and its brand alive by moving beer-making operations into Strange Craft Brewing's taproom.

A few breweries won medals for beers in categories that they aren't exactly known for. For instance, Cannonball Creek Brewing in Golden, which specializes in hoppy brews, won gold for Netflix and Pils, a German-style Pilsner. Ska Brewing in Durango won gold for its brand-new Oktoberfest Vienna-style lager, and Comrade Brewing, which also specializes in hops, won bronze for Defcon Red, an Irish Red.

And speaking of reds, Colorado almost swept the German-style Altbier category when Golden City Brewery took gold for its Legendary Red, while Little Red Cap, from Loveland's Grimm Brothers Brewhouse, won the silver.
