Passport to Golf Rules

- 1. Parent must complete *Passport to Golf* form for child.
- Only "will be" 7th graders in R2-J schools in 2011 are able to get a *Passport to Golf* for the Olde Course. Only "will be" 6th grades in R2-J schools in 2011 are able to get a *Passport to Golf* for Cattail Creek
- 3. Mariana Butte is not part of the program this year. *Passport to Golf* do not extend to Mariana Butte.
- 4. **Passport to Golf** players must present their card to the pro shop each time they play.
- 5. **Passport to Golf** must check in, and receive a receipt for their "use" of the course from the pro shop counter each time they play. They cannot just stay outside while the adult pays.
- 6. Passport to Golf passes are NOT TRANSFERABLE between players.
- 7. Passport to Golf players can play for free ANY DAY after 3 pm. But they MUST be supervised by a paid adult round to play for free.
- 8. An paid adult round can supervise more than one *Passport to Golf* player
- 9. The adult does not have to be a parent, but must be an adult that accepts supervision responsibility.
- 10. An adult is considered to be 18 or over.
- 11. Passport to Golf players must follow all existing golf course rules.
- 12. *Passport to Golf* players must use existing methods to reserve tee time, i.e. online, phone, pro-shop, walk-on.
