RULES & REGULATIONS

- Trails open from 6:00am to 10:30pm daily.
- Overnight parking or camping is prohibited.
- Pets must be leashed and under human control at all times. Owners must pick up and remove pet waste.
- Fishing is regulated by Colorado State
 Regulations. All anglers age 16 and older are required to have a Colorado Fishing License.
- Alcohol, glass containers and smoking are prohibited.
- No open fires or flames. No gathering or cutting firewood, or collecting, removing, destroying, or defacing any natural or manmade object.
- Bicyclists yield to other trail users. Horses and motorized vehicles are not permitted on open lands or trails.
- Noise Ordinance is strictly enforced.
- Remote control (RC) motorized vehicles are not allowed.
- Discharge or use of firearms, projectiles, or fireworks is prohibited.
- Feeding, trapping, hunting, or disturbing wildlife is prohibited.
- Any encroachment or storage of privately owned items on open lands is prohibited.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Trails open from 6:00am to 10:30pm daily, except Mariana Butte and Hidden Hogback trails (open dawn to dusk).
- Overnight parking or camping is prohibited.
- Pets must be leashed and under human control at all times. Owners must pick up and remove pet waste.
- Fishing is regulated by Colorado State Regulations. All persons age 16 and older are required to have a Colorado Fishing License.
- Alcohol, glass containers and smoking are prohibited.
- No open fires or flames. No gathering or cutting firewood, or collecting, removing, destroying, or defacing any natural or manmade object.
- Bicycling permitted on designated trails only. Horses and motorized vehicles are not permitted on open lands or trails.
- Mariana Butte trails are pedestrian use only. No hiking on concrete golf paths.
- Be courteous to others and quiet in active golf zones. Disorderly conduct should be reported to the Pro Shop (970) 667-8308 and may result in expulsion. Noise Ordinance is strictly enforced.
- Remote control (RC) motorized vehicles are not allowed.
- Discharge or use of firearms, projectiles, or fireworks is prohibited.
- Feeding, trapping, hunting, or disturbing wildlife is prohibited.
- Any encroachment or storage of privately owned items on open lands is prohibited.














Welcome to Morey Wildlife Reserve

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Trails open dawn to dusk daily.
- Pedestrian use only. Bicycles, horses, and motorized vehicles are NOT allowed on the trails.
- Dogs are NOT permitted at any time.
- Please stay on designated trails.
- No open fires or flames.
- No gathering or cutting firewood.
- Alcohol, glass containers, and smoking are prohibited.
- Please pack out all trash. Littering, graffiti or markings on city property are prohibited.
- Collecting, removing, destroying or defacing any natural or manmade object is prohibited.
- Feeding, trapping, hunting, or disturbing wildlife is not permitted.
- Discharge or use of firearms, projectiles, or fireworks is prohibited.
- Noise Ordinance is strictly enforced.
- Private landscaping or use of city property, including extensions of backyard landscaping, trash or rubbish dumping, or other unauthorized use, is prohibited.
- Any encroachment or storage of privately-owned items on city property is prohibited.
- Be aware of wildlife. Snakes and bears may be found in this area.
- Overnight parking or camping is prohibited.
