- Brooding young (use until birds are feathered)
- Nestlings (feathered young, can thermoregulate)
- Fledgling (fledge feathers present, young moved to branches, no longer staying in nest)
- Complete (young have fledged)
- Nest failure (comment if know reason, date)

Other Behaviors/Activities of Adults (mark all that apply, indicate Adult 1 or Adult 2):

- Alerting (acting agitated, focusing on activity near nest, not attending to nest or young)
- Branching (young are stepping out of nest but not yet fledging)
- Brooding (new hatchlings brooded by adult)
- Copulation

- Disturbance (people, cars, noise, etc., that cause birds to leave nest or area)
- Eating (adult eating)
- Feeding (adult feeding one or more young)

- Rousing (puffing up or ruffling/shaking feathers)
- Territorial Display
- Vigilance (normal behavior is interrupted, birds detect/observe a potential threat or stimulus)
- Vocalizing
