CALL TO ORDER:

Commissioner Thorp called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm MT.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Commissioner Pasco motioned to approve the minutes of February 7, 2019. Commissioner Taylor seconded the motion. Passed unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

COUNCIL UPDATE:

- City of Loveland received funding for the sidewalk on Wilson Avenue. Will need matching and other funding.
- Councilor Jersvig will now discuss other sidewalk gaps with council.

COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP OFFICE UPDATE:

- Homeless Strategic Plan. Community meeting next Tuesday. Survey in utility bill newsletter. Will have paper copies as well.
- interSector Partners will come to the June meeting. Commissioners to think about the process and questions during the presentation phase of the process.
- Consolidated Plan. Help with surveys will come from Commissioners Thorp, Warner and Shadduck-McNally. Information will come back to the commission in June to discuss.
- The CPO will provide a training for title company staff to ensure Loveland does not lose affordable housing like Denver did.

APPLICANT QUESTIONS FOR PRESENTATIONS:

A motion to ask the presenting agencies the question, "What have you done in the last year to reduce barriers to your service" was made by Commissioner Shadduck-McNally and was seconded by Commissioner Soreide. Passed unanimously.

LATE REPORTS:

The CPO will send an email to currently funded agencies in early June once their final report has been loaded into Foundant. The email will let them know the form is ready. Commissioner Warner made a motion to include language that if the agency misses their final report date they will not be allowed to apply for funding the following year. Commissioner Pasco seconded the motion. Passed unanimously.

Commissioners asked if Foundant can shut down the reporting process after the due date. Brandy will explore.

SITE VISITS:

Commissioner Soreide presented information from her site visits to the Center for Adult Learning and Easterseals/WINGS

Commissioner Taylor presented information from his site visits to Senior Alternatives in Transportation and Thompson Valley Preschool.

- Commissioner should provide Brandy with food needs and dates absent from presentations.
- The July 4th meeting has been cancelled.
