ORDINANCE NO. 6338

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.20.050(B) OF THE LOVELAND MUNICIPAL CODE TO PERMIT THE CITY CLERK TO INCLUDE PERTINENT OCCUPATIONAL TAX INFORMATION UPON A LIQUOR LICENSE

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that, for purposes of administrative efficiency, the City Clerk need not issue a separate and distinct occupational tax license upon payment of the tax, but may include occupational tax license information upon the liquor license issued by the Loveland Liquor Licensing Authority.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that these proposed amendments to the City Code are desirable and in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOVELAND, COLORADO:


Section 1. That Section 3.20.050(B) of the Loveland Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

3.20.050 Payment.

- B. Upon receipt of the tax payment, it shall be the duty of the city clerk to issue an occupational tax license or include the name of the operator paying the tax, the date of payment, the annual period for which the tax is paid, and the place at which the operator conducts business upon a liquor license issued by the Loveland Liquor Licensing Authority.

Section 2. That as provided in City Charter Section 4-9(a)(7), this Ordinance shall be published by title only by the City Clerk after adoption on second reading unless the Ordinance has been amended since first reading in which case the Ordinance shall be published in full or the amendments shall be published in full. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect (10) days after publication following final adoption, as provided in City Charter Section 4-8(b).
