For comparison, the current average mix of resources supplying Loveland Non-Renewable Subscribers includes: Coal (46.8%), Natural Gas (0.3%), Hydroelectric (12.5%), Solar (3.6%), Wind (30.6%), and Other (6.2%)*. This resource mix was provided to Loveland by Platte River Power Authority for the year 2022.

Prices, Terms & Conditions

GreenSwitch energy is sold in 100 kilowatt-hour (kWh) blocks. The current cost per block is \$1.20. Your bill will increase according to the number of GreenSwitch blocks you purchase. This fee is in addition to the other rates and fees from Loveland Water and Power. To purchase renewable energy, a customer must purchase a minimum of one block (equals 100 kWh).

Renewable energy purchases are subject to a minimum commitment of one year. After one year, the customer's obligation to purchase or the City's obligation to provide renewable energy may be terminated upon 30 days notice by either party.

This optional program is subject to the availability of renewable energy from Platte River Power Authority. The supply may be limited. GreenSwitch is sold by Platte River Power Authority through Loveland Water and Power.
