CALL TO ORDER:

Chair Thorp called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm MT.

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES:

Commissioner Pasco motioned to approved meeting minutes from October 3, 2019. Commissioner Benson seconded. All ayes, motion passed.

INTERSECTOR PARTNERS:

ISP said that this meeting would focus on the grant process and the December meeting would focus on how and what the commission may fund in the future.

The commission and ISP discussed the research and recommendations presented. Discussion was around improving outcomes, funding specific categories and how to understand community needs. ISP will work on an agency survey as a starting point. This information will be transferred to the Consolidated Planning process for community engagement.

The December meeting will include discussing:

- 1) if and how the grant guide should be changed/updated;
- 2) holding presentations for all agencies, just new agencies, or new agencies and those with questions about their proposal;
- 3) funding fewer agencies and letting them know during the January meetings; and
- 4) whether funding decisions should continue to be made using just scoring and blind.

COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP OFFICE UPDATE:

- The next Homeless Strategic Plan study session is currently scheduled for January 28th. The CPO would like two HSC members to meet with council liaisons to talk about next steps. Commissioner Shadduck-McNally said she was available.
- Agencies have been turning in their policies and almost all are approved.
- Next steps in the Consolidated Plan, including the community survey, were discussed with ISP
