Request for Parks & Recreation Commission Member Representative to Work with Staff for Art/Artist Selection for Chilson Project, 1% Art

Commission Member Representative, Bryan Dame, has resigned from the Parks & Recreation Commission. Staff requested a new Commission Member to work on the Chilson Art/Artist selection. Katie Davis volunteered and was unanimously approved by the Commission.

Status on Park Surveillance Cameras, Project & Update on success of Past Initiatives in North Lake Park

Staff discussed actions taken by the three agencies, Parks Staff, Police and R2J School District to address the many problems at North Lake Park, such as closed campus for some students, more patrols by the Police Department and more staff in the area during the day. These actions have helped reduce the amount of vandalism and trash in the park area. The security camera equipment has been received and is in the process of being installed at several locations.
