Historic Preservation Commission
Meeting Summary
February 18, 2019

A meeting of the Loveland Historic Preservation Commission was held Monday, February 18, 2019 at 6:00 P.M. in the Development Center at 410 East 5th Street, Loveland, Colorado. CALL TO ORDER

Commission Chair Askeland called the meeting to order at 5:59 p.m.

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

Commissioner Kersley made a motion to approve the agenda. Commissioner Cox seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

CITY COUNCIL UPDATE

Councilor Fogle gave a brief update of Council matters and expanded on the Broadband project's recent issues, as well as budget discussions.

STAFF UPDATE

Nikki Garshelis reviewed the staff report, which included the following items:

- **Downtown Design Guidelines** - A CSU intern has been recruited to assist in creating a separate Downtown Design Guideline Document for the City.
- **Survey Grant Application** - The CLG grant application has been submitted and grant awards will be announced in late March.
- **McCreery House Loan Application** - Legal Staff reviewed the approved McCreery Loan Application and is on standby until work is completed and receipts are submitted
- **June is Bike Month** - The HPC to hosting the Historic and Architectural Bike Tour on Saturday June 15
- **HPC Forum January 14** – Feedback from the Loveland HPC Forum was excellent
- **Instagram:** The Loveland Historic Preservation site currently has 762 followers
- **DC Winter Newsletter:** The newsletter featured the Historic Kelley Coffman House and was sent to over 2700 email Subscribers.
- **Conference Silent Auction** - HPC Donated a Loveland Gift Basket to the Saving Places Silent Auction and the last bid was \$95
- **History Colorado Roadside Marker Program** – Two Loveland Markers were identified, The Barnes Marker, and the Loveland Marker. The Loveland Marker is in need of repairs, and staff will suggest relocating the marker closer to Loveland

66 **GREAT WESTERN RAILROAD & FREIGHT BUILDING UPDATE** – Mike Perry, President of Loveland Historical
67 Society shared that the project is moving forward. There was discussion about the cost of the project, as
68 well as efforts to help offset the cost associated with the project such as Grants, and fundraising
69 opportunities.

71 **HPC FORUM REVIEW & SAVING PLACES CONFERENCE REVIEW** – Commissioners agreed that both events
72 were successful and well attended. Commissioners also agreed that the Saving Places Conference
73 provided really good seminars as well as guest speakers.
