IV. Lee Farm 1st Subdivision Planned Unit Development.

A public hearing to consider a phased Planned Unit Development (“PUD”) Preliminary Development Plan (“PDP”) and subdivision Preliminary Plat for the 246.86 acre Lee Farm 1st Subdivision in NW Loveland. The project includes 5 housing types and densities, a small neighborhood commercial area, and a community center with a private park and athletic fields. If approved, the PDP will qualify for vested rights. No mineral rights hearing is necessary. The property is located along the west side of North Wilson Avenue between Buck PUD and Hunter’s Run PUD. Planning Commission action is quasi-judicial and would be final, subject to appeal to City Council.
