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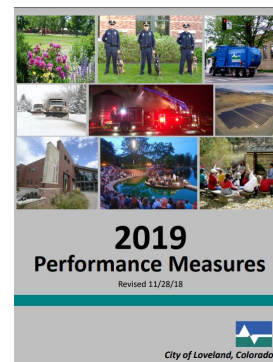


What are we doing now?

Performance Management Program

- Prioritizes workload measures
- Static document

- Serves as a shortlist of measures in the standalone performance management program document

Citywide Strategic Plan

- Lists broad objectives/measures for each strategic focus area

Workload Measures

INPUT MEASURE

What are we putting
in?

Examples:

- Staff hours
- Dollars
- Equipment/supplies

OUTPUT MEASURE

How much are we
doing?

Examples:

- Number of affordable housing units created
- Number of library cards issued
- Total Rialto active days

Outcome Measures

EFFICIENCY MEASURE

Ratio of inputs to
outputs

Examples:

- Maintenance costs per square foot
- Cost per million gallons of water treated
- Technician hours per lane mile of road repaired

EFFECTIVENESS MEASURE

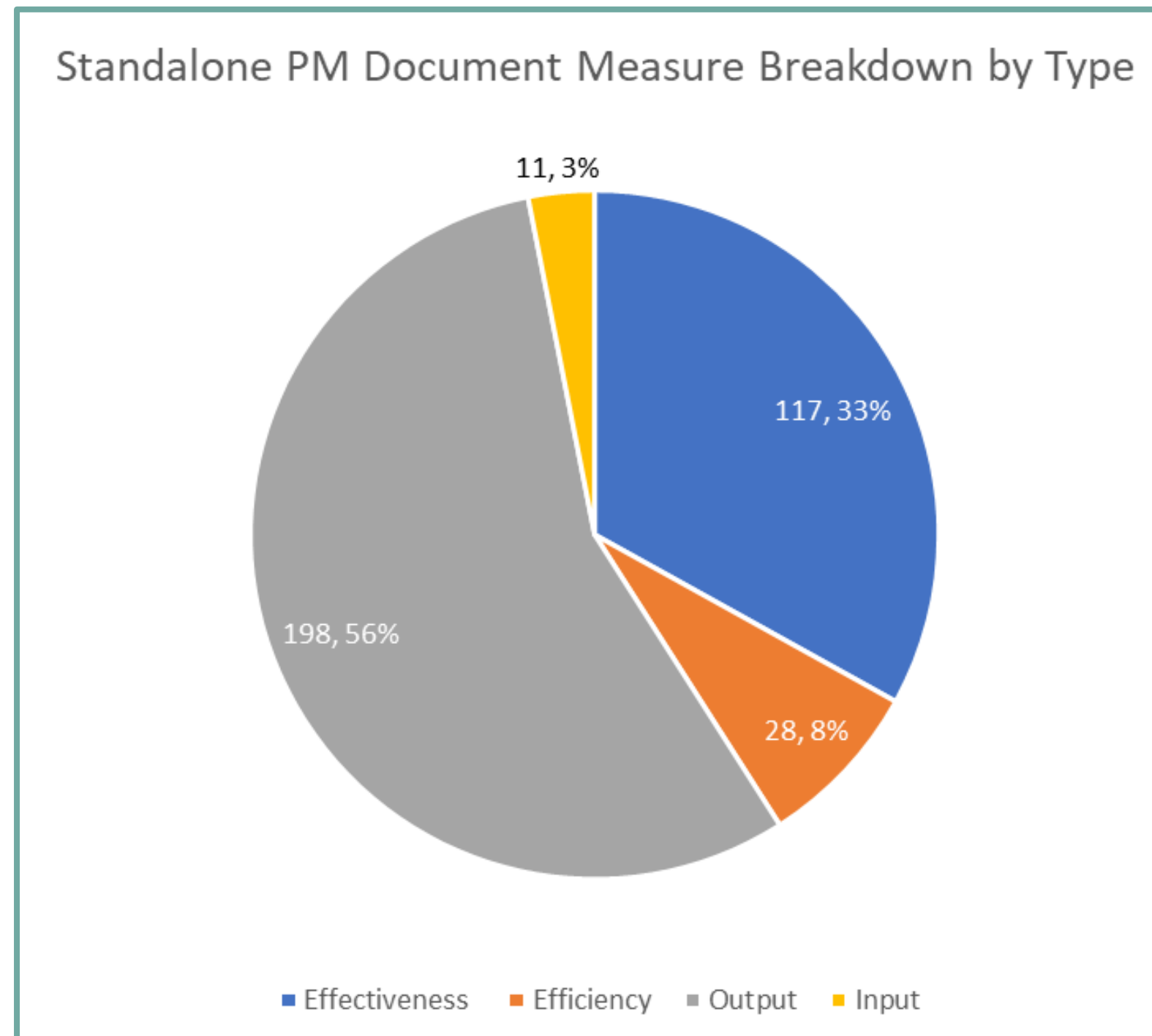
How well are we

Examples:

- Police/fire response times
- Employee turnover rate
- Building permit average days for review

1 Benchmarking

- Sunset PM document
- Move from static reporting to dashboard tool
- Prioritize outcome measures

2 Budget Book

- Report benchmark measures as well as city-specific measures that are not suitable for benchmarking

After our proposed program revisions, we have 85 benchmark measures and an additional 14 budget book measures (99 total across the organization).

Benchmarking

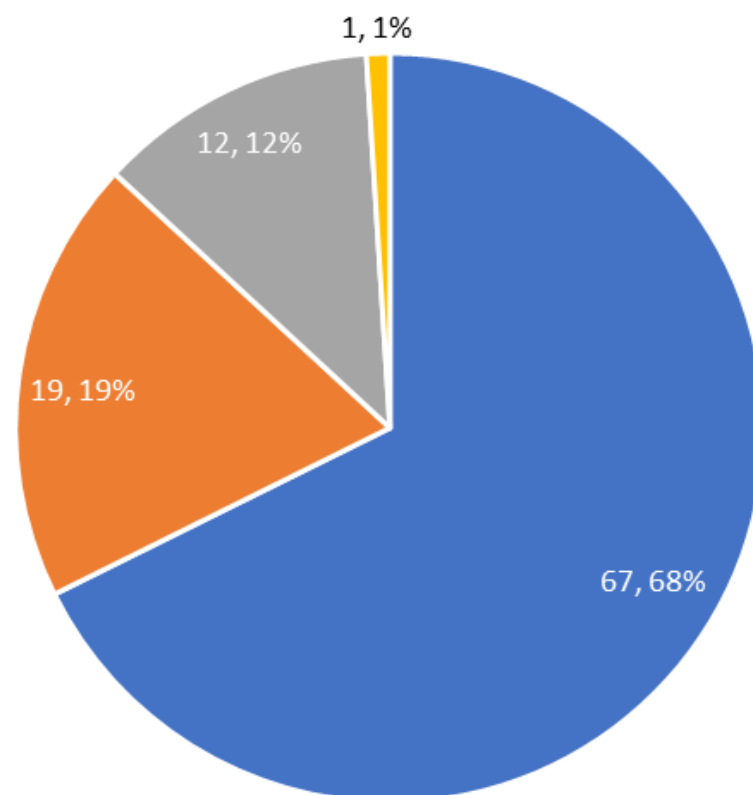
- Allows us to compare our own performance with similarly-sized and/or similarly-situated municipalities across Colorado and the U.S.
- Helps us understand our regional competitiveness across key service delivery areas.
- Serves as a visual tool for residents to evaluate the performance of the city organization.



Revised Measure Overview

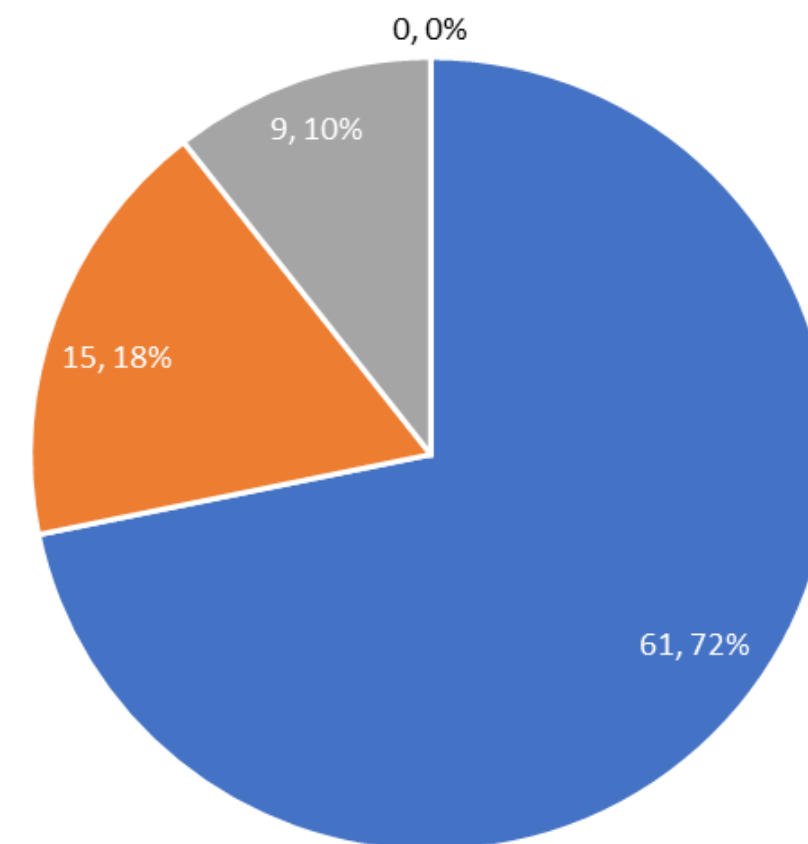

Department and division managers had more industry-specific knowledge of their service areas - their input heavily guided these final recommendations!

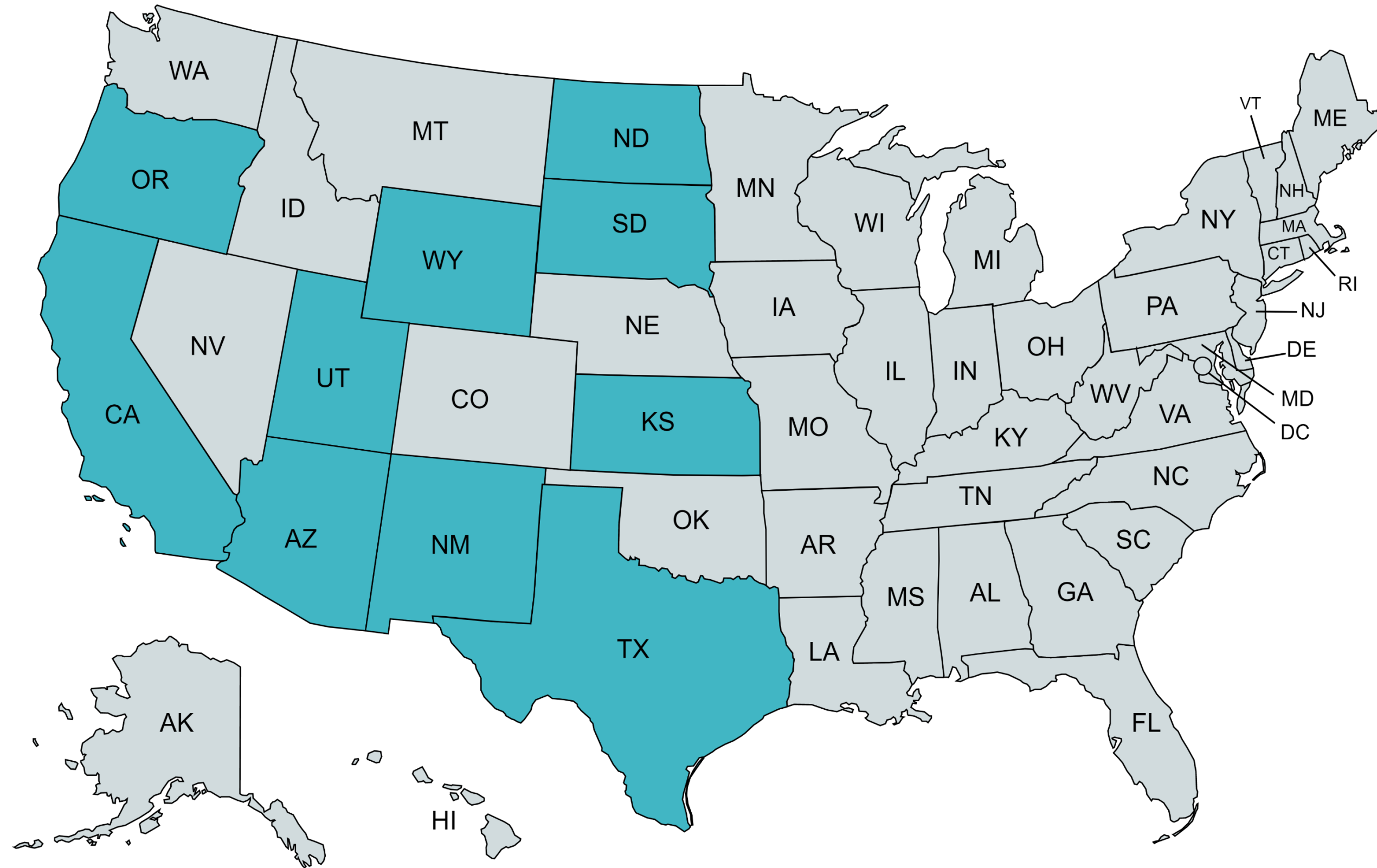
