

City of Loveland 2022 Patio Program Temporary Permit Checklist



All of the following information is required to be submitted with a completed Temporary Permit Application. Please submit with accompanying check in the amount of \$150 payable to the City of Loveland. This fee is nonrefundable.

Exhibit A	Site Plan drawing with proposed outdoor dining area dimensions indicated, including sidewalk width and pedestrian right of way that meets required accessibility standards; placement of tables, chairs, umbrellas, tents and other allowable fixtures. If using umbrellas or tents, note how these will be weighted down. See attached Site Plan drawing example for assistance.
Exhibit B	Either execution of a "Revocable License Agreement" for the use of public property or a lease, deed, or other written permission to use private space for the outdoor activity.
Exhibit C	If on City property, Certificates of Insurance naming the City as an additional insured in the amount of $$1,000,000$.
☐ Exhibit D	 Written Control Plan that includes: Hours of operation Signage plans Plans for music or entertainment Security measures Description of barriers used to maintain boundaries of new space to be added Lighting plans Acknowledgement of all applicable City rules and regulations
☐ Exhibit E	IF PROPOSING THE SALE OF LIQUOR: A Liquor License/Temporary Modification of Licensed Premises – State Form DR8442 – Permit Application and Report of Changes. Accompanying check for fees of \$300 payable to the Colorado Department of Revenue must be included.

NOTE: Submittal of an Application is not an approval to set up an Outdoor/Sidewalk Dining Facility. Do not set up your patio before you are contacted by City of Loveland staff.
