




- P2 Pump Station will provide current and future domestic water & fireflow demands for the northwest portion of the City.

- Pump Station Construction slated for 2022-2023




EAST EXTERIOR ELEVATION



WEST EXTERIOR ELEVATION




SOUTH EXTERIOR ELEVATION
