EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 6554 A

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ENACTING A SUPPLEMENTAL
BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION TO THE 2022 CITY OF LOVELAND
BUDGET TO ADDRESS UNAUTHORIZED ENCAMPMENTS**

WHEREAS, the City has reserved funds not anticipated or appropriated at the time of the adoption of the 2022 City budget to address Unauthorized Encampments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to authorize the expenditure of these funds by enacting a supplemental budget and appropriation to the 2022 City budget to address Unauthorized Encampments, as authorized by Section 11-6(a) of the Loveland City Charter; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4-10 of the Loveland City Charter this Ordinance must be adopted as an emergency ordinance as the appropriation must be made as soon as possible in order to address unauthorized encampments for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Loveland; and

WHEREAS, the emergency conditions necessitating this Ordinance are set forth more fully in the contemporaneous and companion Ordinance No. 6554 B entitled “An Emergency Ordinance Amending the Loveland Municipal Code to add a new Chapter 9.47 Concerning Unauthorized Encampments and the Addition of a New Chapter 7.29 Concerning the Civil Abatement of Unauthorized Encampments Necessary for the Immediate Preservation of Public Property, Private Property, Health, Safety, and Welfare to Mitigate the Unreasonable Risk of Fire and the Deterioration of City Property Caused by the Propagation of Unauthorized Encampments.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOVELAND, COLORADO:


Section 1. That reserves in the amount of \$500,000 from Unassigned Fund Balance in the General Fund are available for appropriation. Such revenues in the total amount of \$500,000 are hereby appropriated to the 2022 City budget to address Unauthorized Encampments. The spending agencies and funds that shall be spending the monies supplementally budgeted and appropriated are as follows:

Section 2. That the City Council finds and determines that an emergency exists requiring immediate passage of this Ordinance in order to address unauthorized encampments as quickly as possible for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Loveland.


Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon final adoption, and the City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in full following final adoption pursuant to requirement of Loveland City Charter Section 4-10(b).
