

TOP 10 THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT THE JULY 4TH FESTIVAL AT NORTH LAKE PARK



1. The **fun** kicks-off at **3:00pm** on **MONDAY, JULY 4th**

KID ZONE & VENDORS

3:00pm- 8:00pm, near the playground. The Kids Zone will include the Mobile Recreation Trailer, face painters, balloon artists, glow products, food & drink vendors and FUN!

EXCEPTIONS – Buckhorn Northern Train runs from 10:00am – 6:00pm, NERF Battle Arena 3:00pm – 6:00pm, Giant Building Blocks 3:00pm – 6:00pm.

2. There will be **live MUSIC** all afternoon – [Creole Stomp](#) at 3:00pm, [Wood Belly](#) at 5:30pm, [Loveland Concert Band](#) at 8:00pm. No chairs will be allowed around the amphitheater lawn until after 8:00pm.

3. There will be lots of **FOOD & DRINK** available at the park! Food vendors & trucks will be located in the Kids Zone area and Beer Garden (anyone can enter the beer garden, but must have bracelet to purchase alcohol). See vendor list for complete details.

4. **RIDEShare encouraged** – RIDESHARE DRIVERS: maps available at [lovgov.org/july4th](#)

Parking: handicap accessible parking is available on 29th Street between Beech and Taft. Paid parking is available at Loveland High School.

5. The **Beer Garden** will be open until 8:30pm; last call at 8:00pm. [Big Thompson Brewery](#) and [Loveland Aleworks](#) will be pouring the drinks.

6. **CORNHOLE TOURNAMENT** – the cornhole tournament requires advanced registration, by June 30th. There will be cash prizes for the top two teams - \$200 & \$100, respectively. Registration is for one team (2 ppl). [Register Here](#)

7. **CHILDREN'S BIKE PARADE** – the parade is free to participate and is intended for children 8 and under. Staging at 3:30pm south of the playground. The parade route will wrap around the playgrounds, go north of duck pond and head south towards Hammond Amphitheater. Kids will do a short loop in front of the stage, where the judges will be located and then will return to the staging area. The entire route is just under half a mile. Register [here](#).

8. **fireworks** will be launched from the beach along the north side of Lake Loveland. [99.9 The Point](#) will broadcast commercial free from 6pm – 12pm on July 4th, with the official soundtrack to the Loveland Fireworks Show!

9. **SWIM BEACH CLOSURE** – Saturday, July 2nd – Tuesday, July 5th – midday! Due to the heightened restrictions around large scale fireworks shows we must maintain a 700ft perimeter around the launch zone. This closure must be in place prior to the fireworks being brought on-site.

10. **WHAT TO BRING:** spending cash, blankets and a great attitude. Do not bring alcohol, illegal fireworks and bad attitudes.
