NON-ACTION ITEMS – INFORMATION

Financial Report Rod Chapman reported on revenues and rounds year to date through 6/22/2010 compared to 2009. In summary, rounds are less than 2009 by approximately 10977 rounds; revenue is below 2009 levels by \$136, 844.
Jim Corlett asked why the 2011 budget was based on 2009 levels and not 2010 levels. Rod said the projections are based on the thought that the rest of 2010 will recover to 2009 levels. Rod also said that a new Weekend Twilight Special on Fri, Sat, and Sun would be offered at the courses.

Andrea distributed June 2010 revenues to date and 2010 May month-end comparisons.

2011 Budget Process Corrected information on the 2011 proposed budget was not available.
