INITIAL STATEMENT OF PETITION SUFFICIENCY

I, Angie Sprang, Interim City Clerk, do hereby certify that:

1. On Monday, August 5th, 2024, petition representatives Autumn Todd and Tom Wilczynski submitted a petition to initiate a Charter amendment that would permit retail marijuana establishments to exist in the City of Loveland in accordance with applicable State and Local laws and regulations; and
2. Said petition requested that the Charter amendment be placed before the voters at the November 5, 2024 special municipal election; and
3. A petition seeking consideration of a Charter amendment at a special election must be signed by registered electors of the City equal in number to at least five (5) percent of the registered electors of the municipality, as of the filing of a Notice of Intent; and
4. The number of signatures of registered voters who live within the Loveland city limits required for said petition to be sufficient is 3,215; and
5. Upon examination of the petition, I have determined that the petition contains more than 3,215 valid signatures, and the petition is therefore sufficient for placement on a special municipal election ballot.

INITIAL STATEMENT OF PETITION SUFFICIENCY

I, Angie Sprang, Interim City Clerk, do hereby certify that:

1. On Wednesday, August 7th, 2024, petition representatives Dave Clark, Earle Sethre, and Marvin Childers submitted a petition to initiate a recall of Troy Krenning as Ward 1 City Council Member and demand the election of a successor; and
2. Said petition requested that the recall be placed before the voters at the November 5, 2024 special municipal election; and
3. A petition seeking consideration of a recall at a special election must be signed by registered electors of the City equal in number to at least twenty-five (25) percent of the 2023 registered electors vote cast of Ward 1, as of the filing of a Notice of Intent; and
4. The number of signatures of registered voters who live within the Loveland city limits required for said petition to be sufficient is 1,615; and
5. Upon examination of the petition, I have determined that the petition contains more than 1,615 valid signatures, and the petition is therefore sufficient for placement on a special municipal election ballot.
