The City of Loveland is currently accepting applications for the Construction Advisory Board (CAB). The Board has a key role in reviewing and updating Loveland's building codes and amendments.

The deadline to apply is July 2, 2025, at 5:00 p.m.

CAB OVERVIEW:

- 9-member Board reviews, the uniform construction codes, Title 15 amendments, and code appeals.
- CAB recommendations are forwarded to the City Council.
- Over the past few years, the CAB has updated City codes to comply with the most current International Codes.
- Training is available to all new and returning commissioners, no previous commission experience is needed.

IS THERE A DESIGNATED TERM FOR SERVICE?

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a City of Loveland resident or own a construction related business in Loveland.
- Experience in the construction field is mandatory.
- Currently looking for an experienced plumber, solar contractor, and/or architect.

WHAT IS THE SCHEDULE FOR CAB MEETINGS?

- The Board has regularly scheduled meetings on the 4th Wednesday of each month.
- Meetings are scheduled from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. but may go longer.
- Meetings are canceled when no business is scheduled.
- Additional study sessions may occur when major policy and code changes are under consideration.
