

TEMPORARY SIGN STANDARDS Election Yard Signs

Temporary signs can be posted in Loveland city limits if the person who posts them follows the City's Unified Development Code, Section 18.04.08.09: Temporary Signs. Please review the code at lovgov.org/UnifiedCode and contact us if you have guestions!





WHAT'S ALLOWED

Location: At least 2 feet from sidewalks and property lines and out of rights of way (includes roads, medians, curbs, parkways, roundabouts, and sidewalks)

Number: Maximum of 12 signs per property

Duration: Up to 10 signs may be displayed during two time periods of up to 60 days each year, which may be stacked. Up to two signs are not time restricted.

Sign Height: Up to 4 feet

Sign Area: Up to 6 square feet

Lighting: No lighting or illumination

Permit: Not required



Non-Residential



WHAT'S ALLOWED

Location: At least 2 feet from sidewalks and property lines and out of rights of way (includes roads, medians, curbs, parkways, roundabouts, and sidewalks)

Number: Maximum of one sign for every 80 feet of

property frontage (as measured in a line)

Duration: Signs may be posted during two time periods of up to 60 days each year, which may be stacked

Sign Height: Up to 4 feet

Sign Area: Up to 6 square feet

Lighting: No lighting or illumination

Permit: Not required



NOT ALLOWED

- Attaching signs or banners to fences, Tposts, trees, or poles
- Placing banners or feather flags on residential property (except for multifamily)
- Attaching signs to anything other than a H or U frame metal support structure posted in the ground
- Posting yard signs in the Downtown Sign District







TEMPORARY SIGN STANDARDSElection Site Signs

Site Sign: A sturdy, temporary sign that typically measures the size of a sheet of plywood.



Non-Residential



WHAT'S ALLOWED

Location: At least 2 feet from property lines and out of rights of way (includes roads, medians, curbs, parkways, roundabouts, and sidewalks)

Number: Maximum of one sign for every 600 feet of property frontage (measured in a straight line). If more than one sign is allowed, they may be clustered.

Duration: Site signs may be displayed for up to 180 days in a row per calendar year

Sign Height: Up to 6 feet, including support posts

Sign Area: Up to 32 square feet

Lighting: No lighting or illumination

Permit: Required





NOT ALLOWED

- Site signs attached to fences, buildings, or vehicles
- Site signs on residential properties that are 2.5 acres or smaller.



Residential



WHAT'S ALLOWED

Exception for Large Residential Properties: The location, duration, sign size, lighting, and permit information included above for site signs on non-residential property also applies to residential properties that are larger than 2.5 acres.

Properties that are larger than 2.5 acres may have a no more than one site sign per street frontage.
