1 FIND AND FIX LEAKS

Replace washers in dripping faucets. One drop per second wastes 2,700 gallons of water per year.



2 ADD AERATORS

Retrofit bathroom faucets with 1 gallon per minute (gpm) faucet aerators.

3 PREVENT LEAKY TOILETS

To check for toilet leaks, add a couple drops of food coloring to the back tank. If color appears in the bowl, you have a leak. You can save thousands of gallons per year by repairing a leaky toilet.

4 BUY WATERSENSE® PRODUCTS

5 TOSS, DON'T FLUSH

Put tissues, dead bugs and so-called "flushable" wipes in the trash rather than the toilet.

6 SHORTEN YOUR SHOWER

Shorten your shower time by just 1-2 minutes - saves up to 700 gallons per year.

7 BRUSH THEN WASH

Brush your teeth first while waiting for the water to get hot, then wash your face or shave.

8 SHOWER SMARTER

9 COMPOST

Use the compost bin or trash can to dispose of food rather than putting it down the garbage disposal - saves 50 to 150 gallons per month.

Avoiding running water to defrost food - saves 50 to 150 gallons per month.

13 FIND YOUR MASTER SHUTOFF VALVE

In an emergency, this can save water and prevent water damage to your home.
