He 27 reported the Garden Gate appeal would be heard by City Council February 7. 28 29 **CITIZEN REPORTS** 30 31 There were no citizen reports. 32 33 **ELECTION OF OFFICERS** 34 35 Commissioner Middleton made a motion to nominate Buddy Meyers as Chair. Commissioner Ray 37 made a motion to nominate Commissioner Crescibene as the Zoning Hearing Officer and 38 Commissioner Dowding as the alternate hearing officer. 20 21 22 23	Mr. Paulsen reported the 402 Corridor Plan was identified as one of City Council's priorities at their recent Advance and he would provide the Commission with a copy of City Council's 2012 goals.		
24 25 26	Commissioners Dowding and Middleton stated they would like more communication with the City Manager.		
27 28 29 30 31	There was a discussion regarding the timelines for the development review process. Mr. Paulsen stated that review times have been reduced overall and staff continues to work on ways to improve. He clarified the Title 18 Committee has identified this as one of their goals. It was suggested and agreed that staff would give a quarterly report on the process.		
31 32 33 34 35 36 37	Mr. Paulsen indicated that he would revise the 2011 Accomplishments / 2012 Goals document based on the Planning Commission comments and provide an adjusted version for the Commission's review on February 13 th .
